Curriculum Focus

We have been enjoying the annual **Mission Impossible Game** in the gym. Quite likely your child might have mentioned it. The Mission Impossible Course is designed to challenge student's skills and abilities in order to complete a variety of challenge stations safely and successfully. It showcases all of the physical literacy skills that kids are continually developing as they grow, move, and play. It is also a **TEST of FOCUS** for students because they must be quiet while participating, which at the end of the school year is pretty impossible LOL.

Gymnastics will begin after Sports Day until the end of the year. This is always a favorite time as we often have guest gymnasts spend some days with us working on gymnastics skills. I truly believe gymnastics is the greatest developer of coordination, strength, and flexibility for children. In our Gymnastics lessons we will learn and practice the many floor elements including; the handstand, stork stand, tuck jumping, forward and backwards rolling (somersault), cartwheeling, leapings, and landings. We will also use the bar to learn pullovers, front supports, skin the cat pike, and a front rollover dismount. For the balance beam we will learn how to walk, do a pivot turn, and simple dismounts.
